Requirements:

- Home Health Aide (HHA) certification is preferred, but we will accept other applicants from the medical field as well. HHA certification training can be provided for suitable candidates.
- Prior experience working with elders is preferred.
- Must be able to regularly lift up to 30 pounds, and to spend long periods of time walking/standing.
- Must be at least 18 years of age.

Responsibilities include assisting with:

- Personal care and administering medications
- Social and recreational activities

- Meal services, including setting up tables, serving meals and cleaning the dining room
- Maintaining a clean, comfortable and safe environment
