The Position: We're looking for a part-time (24 hours per week) home health aide, particularly to help cover the weekend shifts. Also, care staff are eligible for an additional \$1/hour differentials for weekends and night shifts.

- Saturday & Sunday regular HHA day shift (5:45am-2:15pm); Monday & Tuesday 8am-12pm

Requirements:

- Home Health Aide (HHA) or PCA certification is required.
- Prior experience working with elders is preferred.
- Must be able to regularly lift up to 30 pounds, and to spend long periods of time walking/standing.
- Must be at least 18 years of age.

Responsibilities include assisting with:

- Personal care and administering medications
- Social and recreational activities
- Meal services, including setting up tables, serving meals and cleaning the dining room
- Maintaining a clean, comfortable and safe environment
- Cleaning resident rooms
