

Visitation Policy during COVID-19

Camphill Ghent

Updated September 15, 2021

Visitation is only permissible if there is no positive case of COVID-19 at Camphill Ghent. Any visitation must end if any staff person or resident tests positive subsequent to allowing visitation.

- The visitor must be 18 years of age or older or accompanied by an adult 18 years of age or older.
- Visitors will be screened for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 prior to resident access and are refused access if they exhibit any symptoms or do not pass the screening questions. Visitors must pass both temperature and screening checks.
- There will only be two visitors per resident permitted at a time and unvaccinated visitors must remain at least 6 feet away from the resident. Unvaccinated visitors or residents must wear face coverings.
- A staff member will be aware whenever there is a visit with a resident.
- Screening for the visit takes place in front of the adult home.
- Under certain limited circumstances that only Camphill Ghent will determine, visitation will be conducted at a designated indoor area.
- Visitation hours: Monday to Friday, from 10 am to 4 pm only. Other arrangements can be made based on specific requests.

- We will check the temperature of the visitor.
- The visitor must answer the screening questionnaire.
- Visitors are only allowed entry to the adult home if they pass our screening check.

During the visit:

- Unvaccinated visitors or residents must wear face coverings.
- Unvaccinated visitor must maintain a safe distance of six feet from the resident and staff.
